This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Airstream has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in the model year 2023 Rangeline touring coach. As a result, Airstream is conducting a safety recall.

Reason for this recall	Airstream, Inc. (Airstream) is recalling 2023 Rangeline touring coaches equipped with the Onan 2.8 HGLAA-8302 (Gasoline) generator. Per Cummins Recall 23E030, "The fuel hose between the inline fuel filter and the injection pump module (IMP) may have inadequate clamp force, possibly resulting in a gasoline leak." If a gas leak occurs, this could result in a fire, personal injury and/or property damage.
What we will do	Because this is Cummins' recall, the inspection and recall repair will need to be completed by a Cummins certified service center. To locate the nearest certified service center, please call 1-800-CUMMINS (286-6467). You may also find a location nearest you by searching the web at <u>www.cummins.com/locations</u> . The recall repair will be done at no cost to the customer. This repair will take approximately .50 hours.
What we need you to do	Please contact Cummins immediately to schedule a service appointment to have the repair performed on your vehicle's Onan generator.
