

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This notice applies to your vehicle NHTSA Recall No. 23V284 TS#: 2013 Issue Date: March 29, 2023 Product / Part Number[s]: Warn VR EVO 8 Winch

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Crysteel Manufacturing Inc has decided, based on information provided by Warn, that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2021-2023 Junk King Model Trucks, PN: 2315373, JUNK KING-1901955-INST/PKG 2020 vehicles, equipped with a Warn model EVO 8 Winch.

Issue / Symptom / Failure Mode:

Remotes have been reported by Warn to have failed after exposure to water. The remote-can shortcircuit, causing the Winch to operate on its own and increasing the risk of injury.

<u>Root Cause:</u> According to Warn, inadequate sealing around the remote seam can allow water to enter the unit.

Corrective Action:

Please reference the associated link below with instructions on how to eliminate the safety risk by removing the internal battery pack. In addition to the battery removal, Warn is offering a \$100 coupon to customers due to the loss of wireless capability when the battery is removed. Instructions to receive the coupon are also available on the link provided below.
