IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This notice applies to your vehicle: VIN XXXXX
NHTSA Recall No. 23V-304

Dear XXXX:

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Lordstown EV Corporation (“Lordstown”, “we”, or “us”) has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model Year 2023 Lordstown Endurance vehicles. Our records indicate that your vehicle is included in the affected population of vehicles.

We apologize for this situation and look forward to working diligently to correct this issue.

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| What is the issue? | On your vehicle, the driver information display may freeze and become disabled upon start-up. |
| What is the risk? | If the driver information display freezes and becomes disabled, then information such as the speedometer, battery charge gauge, and certain indicator lamps and warning messages, as well as acoustic warnings would not be available. This could result in an increased risk of a crash. |
| What will Lordstown do? | Lordstown will update the software on your vehicle to a version that eliminates this issue at no charge to you. The repair is expected to take about 1.5 hours to complete. |
| What are your next steps? | If Lordstown has not already performed this repair, please contact Lordstown at 1-855-RIDE-LMC (1-855-743-3562) or customerservice@lordstownmotors.com to schedule an appointment for Lordstown to perform this repair. If you do not know whether Lordstown has already performed this repair, please contact Lordstown for this information. |
| What if you no longer own this vehicle? | If you no longer own your vehicle, and have an address for the current owner, please forward this letter to the new owner and also let us know that you no longer own the vehicle. |
