To: All Customers

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Dennis Eagle Inc. has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2020-2023 Proview vehicles. Dennis Eagle have raised a safety recall campaign (CP017) To replace the seatbelt stalk on the left-hand seat for a longer one.

Safety Risk The current left hand side stalk is too short and can be difficult to get to, especially when wearing gloves. Meaning in the event of an emergency it may hinder someone exiting the cab quickly, increasing the risk of injury.

Please contact your local dealer to arrange this free of charge rework quoting CP017. To locate the dealer closest to you, please see <http://www.dennis-eagle.com>. The rework can either be carried out at your premises or at the dealerships depending on your requirements. The remedy is expected to take 1hr to complete. This repair will be done free of charge.
