This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

GILLIG has decided a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain model year 2022 Low-Floor 40' CNG transit buses, manufactured between 08/10/2022 and 12/01/2022. These buses may occasionally experience an electrical failure in the fuse box mounted underneath the driver's platform. The resulting electrical short may cause a thermal event thus increasing the risk of vehicle fire.

As a result of the above, GILLIG has decided to voluntarily initiate a safety recall campaign of the vehicles that may be affected by the issue. Only one customer is affected by this recall.

What The Issue Is:

Certain Low-Floor 40' CNG transit buses may experience an electrical failure in the fuse box.

What GILLIG Will Do For You:

- 1. GILLIG has developed a remedy consisting of the redesign of both 12V and 24V busbars to ensure appropriate and long-term electrical isolation of the affected components. You will receive all necessary parts free of charge along with detailed instructions on how to update all the affected vehicles.
- 2. GILLIG will pay a reasonable warranty claim for performing this function. GILLIG estimates a maximum time of 30 min. per vehicle required to perform this function.

What We Are Asking You To Do:

- 1. We are asking you to follow a procedure to replace the affected parts.
- 2. After the completion of the procedure, return the VIN sheet stating that the recall service has been completed.
- 3. If you have already performed this repair, you are eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of performing the prenotification repair of the issue that is subject of this recall.
