Certain 2022 through 2023 Model Year Porsche 911 Vehicles
Porsche Recall APA8 / NHTSA ID 23V-446

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Porsche has decided that a noncompliance, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2022 to 2023 Model Year Porsche 911 vehicles

What is the issue?

Due to a software error in the rear spoiler control unit, the main Center High Mounted Stop Lamp (CHMSL) is designed to activate when the rear spoiler is retracted, while the auxiliary CHMSL is designed to activate when the rear spoiler is deployed. In certain situations, on the affected vehicles, both CHMSLs are activated in tandem. Simultaneous activation of both CHMSLs on your vehicle does not comply with the applicable regulations and could be confusing to the drivers behind your vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash.

What will Porsche do?

To remedy the noncompliance Porsche will reprogram the affected vehicles with new software that contains the correct rear spoiler CHMSL logic. This repair should take approximately 1 hour to complete, however, it may be necessary to make your vehicle available to your dealer for a longer period of time. Your Porsche dealer will arrange for alternate transportation if necessary.

What should you do?
The remedy needed to complete this recall is now available.

Please contact any authorized Porsche dealer to schedule an appointment to have this recall performed as soon as possible and to arrange for Porsche-provided alternate transportation, if necessary.
