This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Airstream has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model Year 2021-2023 Basecamp (16' & 20') travel trailers. As a result, Airstream is conducting a safety recall.

Reason for this recall	Airstream, Inc. (Airstream) is recalling certain 2021-2023 Basecamp (16' & 20') travel trailers manufactured without the optional roof mounted air conditioner. These units were manufactured with a 12-gauge wire which is intended for future installation of a roof mounted air conditioner. This wire was capped using a Wago connector, but not terminated inside of a junction box. Because the wire was connected to the circuit breaker, and if the Wago connector were to separate from the wire, there may be a potential for a "hot skin" scenario. This could increase the risk of personal injury and/or property damage.
What we will do	Airstream dealers will be instructed to remove the wire from the circuit breaker in the power center. The end of the 12- gauge wire will be insulated with electrical tape & coiled neatly behind the power center. This will eliminate the possibility of a "hot skin" scenario. The repair will be done at no cost to the customer. The repair will take approximately .50 hrs.
What we need you to do	You should contact your nearest dealer immediately to schedule a service appointment to have the repair performed on your vehicle. If you have had the appropriate repairs completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, and if you incurred any direct cost in connection with obtaining such repair, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement from Airstream by contacting the Airstream Customer Service Department.
