Recall Campaign No. 23V-645: Instrument Cluster Glass

Remedy is Available

Dear Rolls-Royce Owner / Lessee:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Rolls-Royce Motor Cars Ltd. has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model Year 2021-2023 Rolls-Royce motor cars. Our records indicate that you are the owner of a potentially affected motor car.

Why are we contacting you?

We are pleased to inform you that we are ready to perform this recall. **We kindly request that you contact your authorized Rolls-Royce Motor Cars dealer to arrange an appointment to have this important update performed as soon as possible.**

What could happen?

It has come to our attention that, if your motor car was involved in certain high-speed side-impact crashes, the instrument cluster glass covering could become damaged, or possibly break. In such a situation, if the glass broke, it could be possible for some of the glass particles to contact vehicle occupants. If this occurred, then in rare cases, this could increase the risk of an injury.

If you are not the only driver of this motor car, please advise all other drivers and passengers of this important information.

What will Rolls-Royce do?

A protective coating will be applied to your motor car's instrument cluster glass free of charge which could take several days.

There may be some options to help overcome the inconvenience of bringing your motor car in for service, if needed. Please contact your local Rolls-Royce Motor Cars dealer to check what may be available.

What if I am not the current owner of this motor car?

If you are no longer the owner of this motor car, please use the enclosed postage-paid postcard to provide us with the name and address of the new owner. If you are a motor car lessor, Federal Regulations require you to forward this notice to your lessee within ten days.

What if I have additional questions?
