

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This notice applies to your vehicle, V	/IN:

Dear General Motors Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

General Motors has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2023 - 2024 model year BrightDrop Zevo 600 vehicles equipped with an optional passenger jump seat. As a result, GM is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we are concerned about your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

IMPORTANT

- Your vehicle is involved in GM recall N232420460.
- Schedule an appointment with your BrightDrop dealer.
- This service will be performed for you at no charge.

Why is your vehicle being recalled?

These vehicles may have been assembled with an incorrect passenger-side upper B-pillar trim panel. An incorrect panel could interfere with proper deployment of the right-side roof-rail airbag ("RRAB") in certain side-impact crashes. In certain side impact crashes in which the RRAB deploys, there is an increased risk of injury to an occupant in the passenger seat.

What will we do?

Your BrightDrop dealer will inspect the right side B-pillar trim and replace if necessary. This service will be performed for you **free of charge**. Because of service scheduling requirements, it is likely that your dealer will need your vehicle longer than the actual inspection and service correction time of approximately 1 hour.

What should you do?

You should contact your BrightDrop dealer to arrange a service appointment as soon as possible.

When scheduling your appointment, confirm with the dealer that they are a BrightDrop certified dealer.
