This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

GILLIG has decided a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain model year 2022 Low-Floor transit buses, manufactured between 04/25/2023 and 06/01/2023, due to potentially incorrect level of the rear axle hub lubricant.

<u>What The Issue Is:</u> The rear axles on the affected vehicles may have an incorrect level of lubricant. An incorrect lube level may compromise lubrication of the wheel hub, causing structural damage with potential loss of vehicle control, increasing the risk of a crash. Consequently, GILLIG is recalling the bus population affected to perform a lube inspection.

<u>What GILLIG Will Do</u> <u>For You:</u> If needed, GILLIG will facilitate communication with Meritor to complete the needed inspection at no cost to you. The inspection should take approximately 30 min. to complete. If necessary, after the inspection the lube oil level will be adjusted as specified. Any damage to the axle parts potentially caused by the low lube oil level issue will be repaired at no cost to the customer.
