

## IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

### URGENT SAFETY RECALL

This is an important Safety Recall. The remedy will be performed **FREE OF CHARGE** to you

October 23, 2024

This notice applies to your vehicle:

WPOBA2Y18N

2020-2023 Porsche Taycan, 2019-2024 Cayenne PHEV, and 2021-2023 Panamera PHEV Vehicles  
Porsche Recall APB6 / NHTSA ID 23V-841

Dear [REDACTED],

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Porsche has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in the 240V NEMA power cable for the mobile charger in certain Porsche Taycan, Cayenne PHEV, and Panamera PHEV vehicles.

#### What is the issue?

Porsche recently determined that the 240V NEMA power cable that comes with your mobile charger can become hot during charging when plugged into certain types of

lower quality electrical receptacles due to elevated electrical resistance at the receptacle interface. This increases the risk of overheating and the possibility of a fire while charging your vehicle

#### What will Porsche do?

To remedy this issue Porsche will replace the 240V power cable with an updated version that has a built-in temperature sensor. This update will be performed **FREE OF CHARGE** to you.

#### What should you do?

The remedy parts to complete this Recall are now available to you **FREE OF CHARGE** at your preferred Porsche Center. Please contact any authorized Porsche Center to schedule an appointment to have this recall performed as soon as possible.

In the meantime, Porsche recommends, out of an abundance of caution, that you stop using the 240V power cable supplied with your mobile charger and instead use either the 120V cable that also comes with your mobile charger, or an appropriate 240V mobile charger from a 3<sup>rd</sup> party supplier.

As a reminder, your owner's manual contains important information about charging the vehicle including but not limited to NEC-qualified installation of industrial-quality electrical receptacles. Porsche encourages you to review the owner's manual to be familiar with this important information.

**What if you are not the owner or operator of this vehicle?**

If you are the lessor and registered owner of the vehicle identified in this action, the law requires you to forward this letter immediately via first-class mail to the lessee within ten days of receipt. If you have changed your address or sold the vehicle, please contact customer support so we can update our records.
