

Procedure:

The affected vehicles were produced with an incorrect Tire and Loading information label (Label - 1) and mistakenly had a Certification Label (Label - 2) installed vs the required Winnebago Altered vehicle label (Label - 3). Both Labels are located inside the driver's side door jamb, on the forward face of the B-Pillar. These labels must be removed or covered with the correct one.

2. Clean the OEM label face with isopropyl alcohol and cover the OEM Tire Inflation Pressure Label with the new Tire and Loading Information Label (Label 1). See Photo C



3. Locate the Certification Label (Label - 2), clean the label face with isopropyl alcohol and cover it with the new Winnebago Altered Vehicle Label (label -3) See Photo D.
