# SUN VISOR AIRBAG WARNING LABEL (SC277)

This bulletin provides the procedure to inspect both left (driver) and right (passenger) sun visors and, if necessary, replace one or both with new one(s) on certain 2023MY Sorento (MQ4a) vehicles produced from October 6, 2022 through August 5, 2023. The airbag warning labels on the driver and passenger sun visors in the affected vehicles may peel off. As a result, the affected vehicles may not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 208 ("Occupant Crash Protection") which requires that each vehicle have a label permanently affixed to each of the sun visors. If the sun visor airbag warning label peels off, the driver and/or passenger may not be warned of the risks of airbag deployment, increasing the risk of injury in the event of a crash. Follow the procedure outlined in this publication to inspect, and if necessary, replace the driver and/or passenger sun visor with a new one. Before conducting the procedure, verify that the vehicle is included in the list of affected VINs.

SUBJECT:

There is no charge to the vehicle owner for this repair. Under applicable law, you may not sell or otherwise deliver any affected vehicle until it has been repaired pursuant to the procedures set forth in this bulletin.

Repair status for a VIN is provided on KDealer+ (Service  $\rightarrow$  Warranty Coverage  $\rightarrow$  Warranty Coverage Inquiry  $\rightarrow$  Campaign Information). Not completed Recall / Service Action reports are available on KDealer+ (Consumer Affairs  $\rightarrow$  Not Completed Recall  $\rightarrow$  Recall VIN  $\rightarrow$  Select Report), which includes a list of affected vehicles.

## SUN VISOR AIRBAG WARNING LABEL (SC277)

#### **Inspection Procedure:**

- 1. Identify the driver sun visor (A).
- 2. Inspect the Airbag Warning Label (B) for any peeling.
  - If peeling is not present (OK), proceed to step 3.
  - If peeling **is** present (NG), proceed to 'Replacement Procedure' on page 3.

The sun visor does <u>not</u> need to be removed to perform the inspection.

- 3. Using light pressure, drag finger down and over the label starting from the top and moving towards the bottom. Repeat in the three (3) sections shown:
  - If peeling <u>is not present</u> (OK), no further action needed.
  - If peeling **is** present (NG), proceed to 'Replacement Procedure'.

**DO NOT** use a tool or fingernail to scrape the label's edge.



Take a photo using the KDS (KVID APP) of the peeling label. **NG** photos **ARE REQUIRED** to be attached to ALL claims.

4. Repeat procedure (steps 2-3) for passenger sun visor.

- 3. Confirm normal vehicle operation.
