Model Year 2022

Inspect Headlamp Adjustment

Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain A-Class and GLA (177 and 247 platform) vehicles, the headlamp adjustment might not meet current production specifications. In this case, the headlamps might be adjusted slightly too high and might exceed the range specified by FMVSS 108 S.10 by approximately 0.05%. A headlamp adjustment that is outside of specifications has the potential to create glare for oncoming traffic, which may increase the risk of a crash. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will inspect the headlamp adjustment on the affected vehicles and correct it, if necessary.

Prior to performing this Campaign:

- VMI must be checked before performing campaigns to verify that the campaign is required on a specific vehicle. Always check for any other open campaigns, and perform accordingly.
- Please review the entire Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.

Approximately 32 vehicles are affected.
