Dear Peterbilt Customer.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2020-2024 536, 537, and 548 vehicles built from 07/31/2019 through 09/08/2023 that are equipped with 2.1m medium duty end of frame trailer connections, tractor protection valves and connecting hoses. Affected vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 121, "Air Brake Systems".

The timing of the trailer brake release may be delayed which can create instability to the trailer and increase the risk of a crash. Truck and Trailer brake application timing is not affected, nor is truck brake performance affected.

What is the problem? The timing of the trailer brake release may be delayed.

What will your dealer do? At this time, parts and procedures necessary to complete repairs are not yet available. You will receive an

updated letter once parts are available.

No action is required on your part at this time. What should you do?

Peterbilt Motors Company has initiated this recall to remedy the issue free of charge. Currently, repair parts and procedures are unavailable to correct this condition. However, Peterbilt is required to notify customers of the existence of the identified safety defect. You will be notified by mail when the parts and procedures become available.
