#### **Chronology** :

From start of production in May, 2021 through Dec, 2023: Continental Tire the Americas, LLC (CTA) received four tires through returns with complaints for suspected belt separation findings with localized tread wear. In all four instances, there was no tread/belt detachment.

Jan-Mar, 2024: Five additional tires were returned with suspected belt separations and one tire with a confirmed belt edge separation.

Apr-Jun, 2024: Eleven tires were returned with complaints of suspected belt separations.

July, 2024: Twenty tires were returned for suspected belt separations and additional four tires with confirmed, visible belt edge separations. None of these twenty-four tires experienced a belt / tread loss. Based on the increase in returns with similar findings and verified belt edge separations, an escalated investigation was initiated.

Aug. 13, 2024: A management review was conducted and CTA made a decision that a safety risk exists and to initiate this recall. To date, CTA has identified thirty-nine tires with suspected tread/belt separation plus six tires with confirmed tread/belt separation. CTA is not aware of any reports of property damage, accidents, injuries, or deaths related to the affected tires.

#### **Description of Remedy :**

Description of Remedy Program :	CTA will conduct a safety recall campaign to replace the subject tires that have been sold, either as original equipment tires or sold in the replacement market. All known customers, distributors, dealers will be notified and given instructions on how to identify the subject tires, information regarding removal from service and return/disposal. CTA will cover the tire replacement cost of affected tires, including any customer, who prior to this recall, replaced these tires due to the condition described above.
How Remedy Component Differs from Recalled Component :	The tire design has been enhanced to improve the tire endurance.
Identify How/When Recall Condition was Corrected in Production :	The enhanced tire design is planned to start production in DOT week 3424

#### **Recall Schedule :**

Description of Recall Schedule :	CTA will notify all customers, distributors, as well as all independent outlets that are authorized to replace the tires that are the subject of this recall, of their responsibilities in accordance with Section 573.6(c) (9). Distributors and outlets will be instructed to return affected tires to CTA to ensure tires are rendered unservicable and disposed of properly.
