#### Chronology :

• On January 22, 2024, the FCA US LLC ("FCA US") Technical Safety and Regulatory Compliance ("TSRC") organization was notified of a potential issue related to a missing front fascia energy absorbing foam on some Jeep Grand Cherokee vehicles.

• From January 2024, through April 2024, FCA US TSRC conducted an analysis of vehicle production history and determined that the affected vehicles may have been built without a front fascia energy absorbing foam.

• On April 17, 2024, FCA US TSRC organization recognized that a vehicle build issue existed on certain vehicles related to a condition that can lead to a front fascia built without an energy absorbing foam, potentially resulting in a noncompliance with FMVSS No. 208.

• On May 10, 2024, FCA US determined, through the Vehicle Regulations Committee, to conduct a voluntary safety recall of the affected vehicles.
