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FMVSS 2: NR Description of the Safety Risk : The customer may experience a blue or black screen or intermittent loss of rear-camera display while the vehicle is in reverse. A loss of the rear camera image while in reverse increases the risk of a crash. Description of the Cause : Dimensions of certain mating interfaces of the tailgate top camera system were out of tolerance and the camera bracket retained water due to orientation in the top tailgate application.
