Between September and mid-Oct., 2024, Porsche became aware of several incidents attributable to center lock fractures.

While the cause remains under review, the subject components appeared to be from a single batch of out-ofspecification components matched to vehicle production months Sept. 2023-Oct. 2024.

Although the cause remains under investigation, Porsche decided on Oct. 21st to conduct a safety recall and ask customers to stop use on the subject vehicles.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Porsche will check the center lock wheel fastening system and replace any out-of-specification parts, if necessary.
