

SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

December 20, 2024

Dear Britax Retailer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Britax Child Safety, Inc. ("Britax") has determined all One4Life® Slim ClickTight® All-in-One ("One4Life Slim") model car seats fail to comply to the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 213 "Child Restraint Systems". If the One4Life Slim seats are installed rear-facing with lower connectors at the 40 lb. weight limit listed on the recalled products, the child may not adequately be protected from injury in the event of a crash. There have been no injuries reported related to this noncompliance.

We would like to assure all caregivers using the One4Life Slim that the car seat can continue to be used safely in rearfacing mode by following the correct weight limit of 35 pounds for the lower connectors. Also, ClickTight installation with the vehicle seat belt (in place of the lower connectors) is the preferred method and offers a quick, easy, and secure installation in both rear- and forward-facing positions. This method also allows you to use the seat to its full rear-facing and forward-facing weight limits for each installation direction.

Britax is working with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) on the timing of the recall as well as the remedy to consumers. Model names and model numbers impacted by this recall are:



If you have any stock of these "E1D197A, E1D197B, E1D197F or E1D197G" model numbers, please remove them from sale immediately and contact your Sales Representative with owned stock details. We will advise you of the next steps once you share model number and quantities.
