

UPDATE Delivery Stop – Vario Top Case for R 1300 GS

Recall 24E-020 has been issued for the Vario Top Case for R 1300 GS

Recall 24E-020 has been issued for the Vario Top Case for R 1300 GS

BMW is announcing a delivery stop for the Vario Top Case for the R 1300 GS for top cases produced up to 02/16/2024, part number 77 43 9 443 542.

This safety recall involves the dealer accessory top case. The locking flap of the top case (fastening the top case to the luggage carrier of the motorcycle) may appear to be securely closed by the user. However, in this condition, the key can be removed. If this occurred, the top case would not be securely fastened to the motorcycle, could detach, and become a hazard for road users.

If you have a top case in your inventory matching the above description, it cannot be retailed and cannot be installed. Please refer to TEC Return (TEC617), issued on February 13th, for instructions to identify and return potentially affected top cases.

NHTSA STATEMENT

Please be reminded that it is a violation of federal law (The Safety Act) for you to sell, lease or deliver any new motorcycle covered by this notification until the recall repair has been performed. This means that dealers may not legally deliver new motorcycles to consumers until they are fixed or use/sell replacement equipment/parts subject to this recall.
