

New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 20B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain MOPAR Side Airbag Inflatable Curtain (SABIC) modules: Right Side Curtain Airbag 68222742AF, Left Side Curtain Airbag 68222743AF, intended for use on 2015 through 2019 model year (LD) Dodge Charger and 2015 through 2020 (LX) Chrysler 300 vehicles. Right Side Curtain Airbag 05108050AF, Left Side Curtain Airbag 05108049AF intended for use on 2011 through 2014 model year (LD) Dodge Charger and (LX) Chrysler 300 vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some SABIC modules may have been manufactured with an inflator that may rupture. A SABIC inflator rupture may result in compressed gas rapidly escaping from the inflator and material potentially being propelled into the vehicle. Material being propelled into an occupied vehicle, or in the direction of a person if the inflator is not installed in a vehicle, may cause injury.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to replace both SABIC modules. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2024.

We ask that you please take the time to ensure that your personnel are aware of this communication and are prepared to execute a customer friendly process for inquiries regarding involved vehicles.

SABIC Inflator - Equipment

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has decided that a defect, which affects motor vehicle safety exists in certain MOPAR Side Airbag Inflatable Curtain (SABIC) modules: Right Side Curtain Airbag 68222742AF, Left Side Curtain Airbag 68222743AF, intended for use on 2015 through 2019 model year (LD) Dodge Charger and 2015 through 2020 (LX) Chrysler 300 vehicles and Right Side Curtain Airbag 05108050AF, Left Side Curtain Airbag 05108049AF intended for use on 2011 through 2014 model year (LD) Dodge Charger and (LX) Chrysler 300 vehicles.

WHY DOES MY VEHICLE NEED REPAIRS?

FCA US records indicate that you may have purchased a SABIC for your vehicle ^[1]. Some SABIC modules may have been manufactured with an inflator that can rupture. A SABIC inflator rupture may result in compressed gas rapidly escaping from the inflator and sharp metal fragments being propelled into the vehicle, or surrounding area if the inflator is not installed. Sharp metal fragments being propelled into an occupied vehicle, or in the direction of a person, may cause injury or death.

HOW DO I RESOLVE THIS IMPORTANT SAFETY ISSUE?

The remedy for this condition is under development and not currently available. We are making every effort to finalize the remedy as quickly as possible, and will service your vehicle free of charge (parts and labor).

FCA US will contact you again, by mail, with a follow-up recall notice when the remedy is available. Once you receive your follow-up notice, simply contact your Chrysler, $Jeep_{\circledast}$, Dodge or RAM dealer right away to schedule a service appointment ^[2]. Additional options for your next steps are included on the left side of this notification. We appreciate your patience.

WHAT IF I ALREADY PAID TO HAVE THIS REPAIR COMPLETED?

If you have already experienced this specific condition and have paid to have it repaired, you may visit **www.fcarecallreimbursement.com** to submit your reimbursement request online.^[3] Once we receive and verify the required documents, reimbursement will be sent to you within 60 days. If you have had previous repairs performed and/or already received reimbursement, you may still need to have the recall repair performed.
