Subject: VOLUNTARY RECALL NOTICE

Dear Michelin Dealer,

Michelin North America, Inc. ("MNAI") has decided to recall forty-six (46) tires of various sizes in the Vintage Tire Collection. (See Appendix A: List of Affected Sizes). These tires were sold into the US market without the letters "DOT", as required by NHTSA regulation 49 CFR Part 574.5 and 49 CFR Part 571.139 S 5.5. You are receiving this letter because our records indicate that you may have received one or more of the recalled tires between May 24, 2024 and October 9, 2024. See Appendix A: List of Affected Sizes.

Tires with the same non-compliance as a current recall (22T023) were inadvertently routed to the North American market from Europe to be sold through general distribution and to be used as recall 22T023 remedy tires.

The Vintage Tire Collection are commonly found on vehicles from the 1940's to 1960's. Jaguar E Type, Chevrolet Corvette, Ferrari 250 GTO, Lamborghini Miura, Porsche 911, and Aston Martin DB5 are a few examples of the tire fitments.

The following chart provides an example of the information needed to identify the recalled tires. TIN information is molded into the sidewall of each tire, directly above the bead. The production code is given by the last 4 digits of the TIN code, with the first two digits specifying the week of production and the second two digits specifying the year of production. For example, a production code of "4123" refers to the 41st DOT week of the year 2023. For information on how to determine the week and year of manufacture for your tires and where to find the letters "DOT", please refer to "Appendix B - Locating Tire Date of Manufacture and "DOT" Symbol."

Alternatively, Michelin will provide you, the Dealer, with the letters to mail directly from your customer list. If you choose to have Michelin send the letters, Please include the following information for each sale:

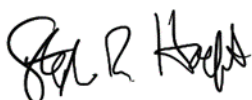

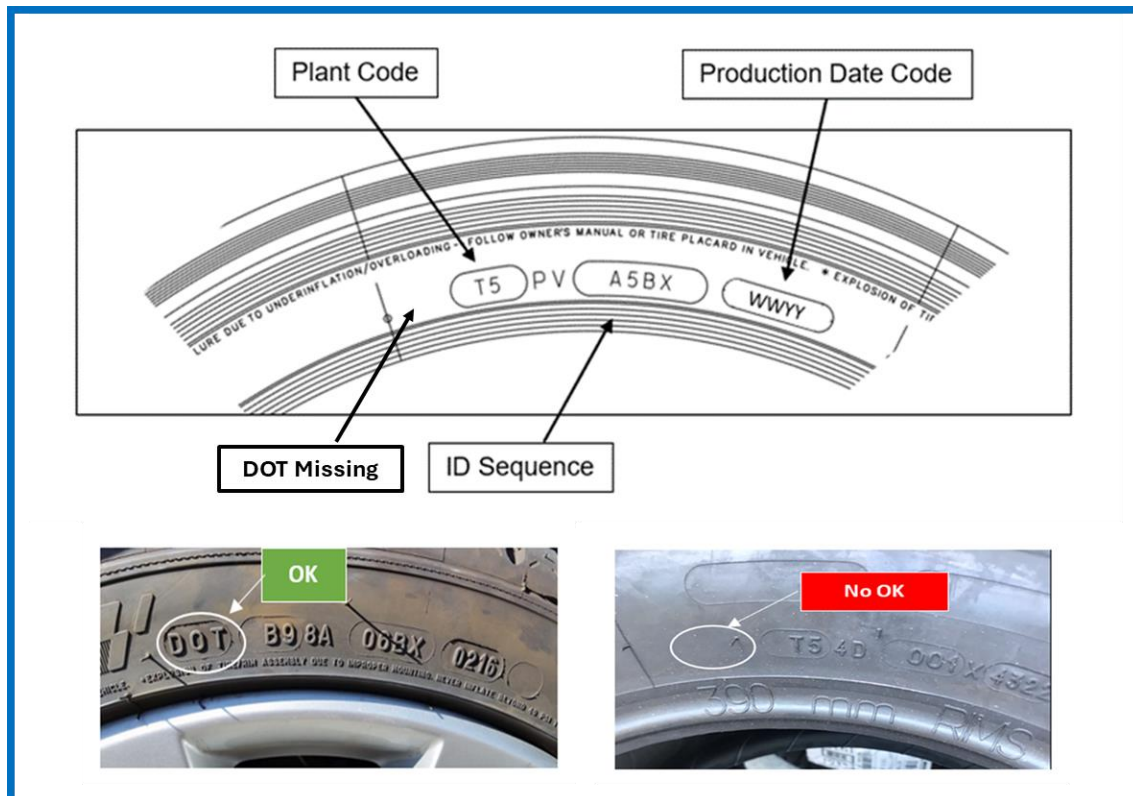

Appendix B - Locating Tire Date of Manufacture and “DOT” Symbol

The Tire Identification Number (TIN) is a string of numbers and letters that includes each tire's plant of manufacture, a unique tire ID and the week and year of manufacture. The TIN is located on the tire sidewall just above the wheel flange. The illustration below shows a sample TIN from one of the affected tires. The production date code is given by the last 4 digits of the TIN, with the first two digits specifying the week of production and the second two digits specifying the year of production.
