PARTS AND SERVICE BULLETIN UPDATE

Please be advised that as of today, February 27, 2024, parts are available in limited quantity for the 2020-2022 RDX and 2020-2021 TLX vehicles. Due to limited parts availability, parts will only be available through a Tech Line request for vehicles with an SRS light that is ON, and a confirmed DTC U3000-49. Please follow the procedures outlined in Service Bulletins 24-015, *Safety Recall: 2020-2022 RDX Seat Weight Sensor (DTC U3000-49)*, 24-017, *Safety Recall: 2020 TLX Seat Weight Sensor (DTC U3000-49)*, and 24-016, *Safety Recall: 2021 TLX Seat Weight Sensor (DTC U3000-49)*.

SUMMARY

On February 1, 2024, Acura issued a **safety recall** for certain model year 2020 & 2022 MDX, 2020-2022 RDX, and 2020-2021 TLX vehicles. **Please refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

As always, be sure to perform an iN VIN status inquiry for all vehicles passing through your dealership to determine eligibility for any open campaigns.
