Please be advised that as of today, February 27, 2024, parts are available in limited quantity for the 2020-2022 RDX and 2020-2021 TLX vehicles. Due to limited parts availability, parts will only be available through a Tech Line request for vehicles with an SRS light that is ON, and a confirmed DTC U3000-49. Please follow the procedures outlined in Service Bulletins 24-015, Safety Recall: 2020-2022 RDX Seat Weight Sensor (DTC U3000-49), 24-017, Safety Recall: 2020 TLX Seat Weight Sensor (DTC U3000-49), and 24-016, Safety Recall: 2021 TLX Seat Weight Sensor (DTC U3000-49).

On February 1, 2024, Acura issued a safety recall for certain model year 2020 & 2022 MDX, 2020-2022 RDX, and 2020-2021 TLX vehicles. Please refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.
