Inspect Headlamp Adjustment

Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain MY19-22 GLC (253 platform) vehicles, the headlamp adjustment might not meet current production specifications. In this case, the headlamps might be adjusted slightly too high and exceed the range specified by FMVSS 108 S.10 by approximately 0.15%. A headlamp adjustment that is outside of specifications may create glare for oncoming traffic, which could increase the risk of a crash. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will inspect the headlamp adjustment on the affected vehicles and correct it, if necessary.

Prior to performing this Campaign:

- VMI must be checked before performing campaigns to verify that the campaign is required on a specific vehicle. Always check for any other open campaigns and perform accordingly.
- Please review the entire Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.

Approximately 15,502 vehicles are affected.
