



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 01B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2023 Model Year (LX) Chrysler 300, (LD) Dodge Charger and (LA) Dodge Challenger vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with an improperly adjusted parking brake. Improperly adjusted parking brakes may lead to a vehicle roll-away increasing the likelihood of a vehicle crash without prior warning and/or injury to persons outside the vehicle, as well as property damage.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.135 S7.12.3 requires that "The parking brake system shall hold the vehicle stationary for five minutes in both a forward and reverse direction on the grade". Vehicles with a suspect parking brake adjustment may not meet this test requirement.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to properly adjust the parking brake. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in the 1st Quarter of 2024.
