

New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 27B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2016 model year (JK) Jeep_® Wrangler Right Hand Drive (RHD) vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with clockspring design that can allow dust or dirt to enter the mechanism when exposed to certain environmental conditions, which can cause a clockspring failure. A failed clockspring will prevent driver airbag deployment in certain crashes, which can increase the risk of injury.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to replace the clockspring, steering wheel back cover, and steering column shrouds. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2024.
