Issue		Mercedes-Benz AG, the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain GLE and GLS (167 platform) vehicles, the 48V ground connection under the passenger seat might have become loose. In this case, the ground cable lug would not be secured correctly. Subsequently, the electric resistance of the connection might increase. In combination with the high electrical currents potentially flowing through this connection, the temperature in this area might increase. As a consequence, a risk of fire cannot be ruled out completely. MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will check the
