



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 44B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on one 2023 model year (WL) Jeep Grand Cherokee vehicle and one 2023 model year (WL) Jeep Grand Cherokee L vehicle.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

The above vehicles may have been built with an improperly fastened rearview camera connection at the Display Screen Module (DSM) which may prevent the camera signal from passing through to the media screen. The vehicle operator will notice that the rearview image is not displayed if attempting to reference the image while backing. If this warning is not heeded, backing up without verifying it is safe to do so could lead to an increased risk of injury to people outside the vehicle.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.111 S6.2.6 requires that "The rear visibility system default to the rearview image being visible and meet the requirements of FMVSS No. 571.111 S6.2.1 (field of view) and S6.2.2 (image size) at the beginning of each backing event, regardless of any modifications to the field of view that the driver had previously selected." Vehicles with improperly fastened rearview camera connections at the DSM may not display the rearview image during a backing event under certain conditions.

SERVICE ACTION

All vehicles in this recall have been remedied by securing the rearview camera connections at the DSM. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods.
