Advance Notice - Compliance Recall 919A / Vehicle Software

This notice is for: All Dealer Personnel

Date: May 17, 2024

Issue:

Certain software characteristics in affected software versions may lead to vehicles experiencing center displays and dashboard displays that do not boot, or that sporadically reset. This can result in loss of speedometer information or loss of rearview camera image. As a result, these vehicles fail to comply with regulatory requirements. If the rear view camera display is delayed or not displaying an image, there is an increased risk of crash or injury when the vehicle is backing up. If the instrument panel display is not working or reboots, the driver would not be able to see important vehicle information (such as the vehicle speed) which could result in an increased risk of a crash.

Repair:

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

<u>Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory:</u> Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
