## **New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 41B**

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2024 Model Year (WL) Jeep® Grand Cherokee Anniversary Edition vehicles.

### **REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL**

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with a missing front fascia energy absorbing foam. If the front fascia energy absorbing foam is missing, the energy management system is altered which may cause the front airbags to not deploy as intended which can increase the risk of injury in a crash.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.208 which specifies vehicle crashworthiness requirements in terms of forces and accelerations measured on anthropomorphic dummies in test crashes, and specifies equipment requirements for active and passive restraint systems. Suspect vehicles built with a missing energy absorbing foam may compromise intended load distribution or energy management and jeopardize proper crash sensing and airbag deployment.

### **SERVICE ACTION**

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to inspect and, if necessary, install the front fascia energy absorbing foam. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 2nd Quarter of 2024.
