Issue		Mercedes-Benz AG, the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain MY 2023-2025 EQE (294 and 295 platform) and EQS (296 and 297 platform) vehicles, the monitoring software of the Battery Management System ("BMS") might not meet curren production specifications and may lead to a shutdown of the high-voltage system in specific situations. The contactors of the high-voltage battery might open, potentially resulting in a loss of propulsion without warning. As a consequence, the risk of a crash might increase. When the vehicle comes to a standstill it can be restarted.		
What We're Doing		MBUSA will conduct a volunta software on the potentially af	tary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will update the BMS ffected vehicles.
