Dear Host Owner(s)/Dealer(s),

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Safety Act (NHTSA).

Host has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2022-2025 Mammoth, Yukon, Cascade, Tahoe, and Everest trailers, equipped with Suburban Slide-In Range models that contain Red LED Backlit Knobs.

Reason for Recall

Explanation of Defect

Part: Suburban Range/Cooktop Model #3629D

<u>Explanation</u>: The LED backlight printed circuit boards (PCB) are not fully coated on Suburban Ranges and ovens. The lack of conformal coating in the connection passages between the layers of the PCB can allow liquid from the cooktop surface to accumulate which could result in a short circuit resulting in the failure of the PCB. If the PCB fails, it can become overheated, and the polyethylene cover of the lights can melt and possibly ignite causing a fire.

What will the Dealer do?

Host in partnership with Suburban will cut the circuit powering the LED backlights and terminate the wiring, or remove the LED backlights at no cost to the customer. This remedy should only take about 30 minutes to complete, but times may vary depending on the dealer. Prior to having the recall remedied, please have the Suburban approved service center (or dealer) contact Suburban to obtain preauthorization and the remedy kit. The dealer can contact
