



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 57B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2024 Model Year (JL) Jeep® Wrangler vehicles equipped with a Trailer Tow Option (sales code AHT).

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with an incorrect Power Distribution Center (PDC) that prevents the trailer lighting from functioning properly. Trailers with inoperative turn signals and stop lamps may result in an approaching vehicle being unaware of the change of direction or speed of the vehicle and trailer, which can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 108 Lamps, Reflective Devices and Associated Equipment TABLE I-b states that trailer turn signal lamps shall "flash when the turn signal is actuated by the turn signal operating unit" and the stop lamps "must be activated upon application of the service brakes." Suspect vehicles may not actuate the trailer turn signals or stop lamps.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the PDC. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in the 2nd Quarter of 2024.
