



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 55B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2022 model year (DJ) Ram 2500 Pickup, (DF) Ram 3500 Cab Chassis GVWR <10K lbs., and (WD) Dodge Durango vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may experience an Anti-Lock Braking System (ABS) control module software malfunction that can disable the Electronic Stability Control (ESC) system. During vehicle start-up an active watchdog failure will illuminate the malfunction indicator lamp. Failure of the ESC system when intervention is expected and/or relied upon can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

The condition above fails to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 571.126 S5.1.2 ESC Functionality requires that the ESC system "Is operational during all phases of driving including acceleration, coasting, and deceleration (including braking) [...]." Suspect vehicles may experience the ESC system being disabled under certain conditions.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to update the ABS control module software. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 3rd Quarter of 2024.
