On June 6, 2024, GM ordered a stop delivery of certain 2024-2025 model year Chevrolet Corvette vehicles via GlobalConnect message GCUS-3-3263.

Additional Chevrolet Corvette vehicles have been added to this stop delivery order. A list of involved vehicles that have been identified as being in dealer new vehicle inventory is attached to this message. It is sorted by dealer Business Associate Code (BAC) for easy reference. Your dealership's BAC will not be listed if none of the involved vehicles are currently in your new vehicle inventory. To identify involved vehicles in dealer used inventory, run an Open VIN Report or Field Action Initiation Report using Field Action Reports-GFAM within the Maxis Dealer Application in GlobalConnect.

Until further instructions are received, involved vehicles that are in dealers' possession (new or used vehicle inventory) must be held and not delivered to customers, dealer-traded, released to auction, used for demonstration purposes, or any other dealer use. All GM Certified Used vehicles currently in the dealers' inventory within the Certified Pre-Owned Inventory System (CPOIS) will be de-certified.

Instructions for releasing the involved vehicles from this stop delivery will be provided in the near future.
