Subject: Safety Recall RVXX2404, Steering Tie Rod Assembly

Description of Defect:

Vehicles may have been built with tie rod assemblies containing a ball stud with improper heat treatment. Failure of the ball stud could result in a sudden loss of steering which increases the risk of a crash. **Owners will be notified and strongly recommended not to drive their vehicles until recall repairs have been completed.**

The remedy will be to inspect the tie rod assembly for the impacted date range. Any suspect tie rod assemblies will be replaced.

Models/ Model Years Affected:

Certain 2025 Volvo VN model vehicles manufactured on May 3, 2024

Vehicle Quantities:

3 (All US)

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal June 10, 2024.
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before June 20, 2024.
