Repair Available – Safety Recall 47DE / Brake Pressure Line Connection

This notice is for: All Dealer Personnel

Date: July 01, 2024

Issue: A potentially overtightened brake line connection can result in a brake fluid leak and cause the affected brake circuit to fail. If this happens, vehicle braking performance will be decreased, increasing the risk of a crash.

Precautions If the recall condition is present in the vehicle, brake pedal travel may be extended and the "Brake fluid level low" warning message will appear in the vehicle display due to the reduced quantity of braking fluid. Due to the diagonal distribution of the two brake circuits, the vehicle can still be slowed with reduced braking power using a front wheel brake and a rear wheel brake.

Customers experiencing this situation are advised to contact their authorized Audi dealer without delay for an appointment to have the vehicle diagnosed.

As a reminder, the vehicle owner’s manual contains important information regarding vehicle warning lights and messages. We encourage owners and anyone who drives the vehicle to review the owner’s manual to become familiar with the types of vehicle indicators, warnings and messaging they may see.

- REPAIR AVAILABLE – July 02, 2024 - Inspect brake pressure line coupling points and, if necessary, replace the affected brake pressure line
 - See ELSA and Service References in Elsa2Go for complete repair & claiming instructions
 - Check daily campaign open inventory report or OMD for affected vehicles in inventory
 - Repair every affected inventory vehicle before delivery to consumers

IMPORTANT REMINDER: VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
