Re: Stop Sale/Noncompliance Recall: 2024 CR-V Hankook Tire Inspection

On June 7, 2024, Hankook Tire America Corp. filed a Part 573 Noncompliance Recall Report (ID# 24T-007) with NHTSA related to certain tires missing the 4-digit week and year code mark in the tire identification number (TIN) required by Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard number 139.

On July 2, 2024, American Honda notified NHTSA of a **stop sale** and **noncompliance recall** for certain model year 2024 CR-V units that are potentially affected by this defect. **Refer to your eResponsibility report or perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.** American Honda expects an extremely small number of tires with a missing TIN date code.

REPAIR

Inspect all four tires for missing TIN date code. Replace tires only if the TIN date code is missing.

<u>PARTS</u>

Replacement tires are available through your authorized Honda Tire Center (Tire Rack). Replaced tires will be collected.

TOOLS

There are no special tools needed for this recall.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Service Bulletin 24-093, Noncompliance Recall: 2024 CR-V Hankook Tire Inspection has posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of July 3, 2024. It includes inspection, parts, repair, and warranty information related to this recall.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

American Honda expects to complete customer notification by mid-August 2024.

As always, perform an iN VIN status inquiry for all vehicles passing through your dealership to determine eligibility for any open campaigns.
