



## **New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 82B**

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2024 (FG) Fiat 500E, 2019 through 2023 (FD) Fiat 500X, 2017 through 2024 (GA) Alfa Romeo Giulia, 2018 through 2025 (GU) Alfa Romeo Stelvio and 2019 through 2023 (BV) Jeep Renegade vehicles.

VINs identified as being involved in this campaign are currently live and searchable.  
**Stop sale is in effect for the above-identified vehicles.**

Vehicles impacted by a stop sale are eligible for reimbursement allowance through the Recall Floorplan Reimbursement Policy (RFPRP), which can be requested upon recall claim submission.

**IMPORTANT:** Some of the involved vehicles may be in dealer new vehicle inventory. Federal law requires you to complete this recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$27,168 per vehicle. Involved vehicles can be determined by using the VIP inquiry process.

### **REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL**

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with a suspect connector on the buckle switch hall effect sensor. A disrupted connector on the buckle switch hall effect sensor may affect the conduction on the connectors of the seat wiring and buckle which may cause the front seat air bag to not perform as expected during a crash. An airbag which may not deploy as intended in the event of a vehicle crash may result in increased risk of injury to the driver.

### **SERVICE ACTION**

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the connector by directly wiring the sensor to the harness with a solder tube. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 3rd Quarter of 2024.
