



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 71B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2021 and 2022 Model Year (KL) Jeep® Cherokee vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with an improperly secured right Side Airbag Inflatable Curtain (SABIC) connector. A SABIC that does not deploy may increase the risk of occupant injury in certain types of crashes.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.214 and 571.226 requires SABIC airbag deployment during certain crash events. An improperly secured SABIC connector may prevent the airbag from deploying in certain types of crashes.

SERVICE ACTION

All vehicles in this recall have been remedied by properly securing the SABIC connector. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods.
