



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 92B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2021 model year (JL) Jeep Wrangler and (JT) Jeep Gladiator vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles equipped with a manual transmission and which received the initial remedy for FCA US Recall ID 19A / NHTSA Recall ID 23V-116 (19A), may experience an improper function of an RPM reduction feature in the Powertrain Control Module (PCM) software. In certain circumstances activation of the Revolutions Per Minute (RPM) reduction feature can result in an engine stall, which can result in a loss of motive power. An unexpected loss of motive power can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to reprogram the PCM with updated 19A recall remedy software. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 3rd Quarter of 2024.
