



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 90B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2024 model year (JL) Jeep Wrangler vehicles equipped with 35 Inch Tires (sales Code SDT) also Blind Spot and Cross Path Detection (Sales Code XAN).

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may have been built with the incorrect tail lamps. Reduced visibility of tail lamps could result in approaching vehicles being unaware of intent to change direction or intent to stop, which may cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

The condition above fails to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 108 S6.4.3(a) requires that "any lamp must not provide less than 1250 square millimeters of unobstructed projected luminous lens area throughout the pattern...Specified in Table V-b". Suspect vehicles may not provide sufficient unobstructed lens area when equipped with the incorrect tail lamps.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the tail lamps. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 3rd Quarter of 2024.
