Reason for this Safety Recall

Winnebago Motorhomes has decided that a defect related to motor vehicle safety exists on certain:

2023 – 2024 Vista, Sunstar, and Adventurer

These motor homes were manufactured **October 10, 2023**, through **March 7, 2024**.

Impacted units will be identified with labor operation code **24871111**. This labor op is for identification purposes only and will be replaced when the recall is activated.

Description

Incorrect wire routing may cause potential damage to the forward-facing camera wiring.

If the camera becomes inoperable, features such as active brake assist, lane keep assist, and auto high beams may become disabled, increasing the risk of a crash.

If the above safety features become disabled, the driver will receive a dash warning.

Service Action

Winnebago will conduct a voluntary safety recall to reroute the wiring, however, the remedy is not currently available. Dealers will be notified through established communication methods once a remedy is available.

We sincerely apologize for this inconvenience and want to assure you we are working diligently to remedy this situation.
