This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Fisker Group Inc. (Fisker) has decided that an issue with the blended braking feature, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in all 2023 and 2024 model years Fisker Ocean vehicles. Fisker has identified a potential issue with the software characteristics of the brake module in its Fisker Ocean vehicles. This issue, which affects the current version of the brake module, may result in a different braking feel due to the drag torque control feature. As a result, Fisker is conducting a Voluntary Safety Recall Campaign effective August 8, 2024, on all MYs 2023 and 2024 Fisker Ocean vehicles manufactured for the U.S.A. and Canada markets.

The current proposed remedy is the release of the over the air new software operating system (OS) 2.2. Once the vehicles in your inventory are updated with the new OS 2.2 software, they then can be released for sale.

On or before October 14, 2024, vehicle owners will be notified with a notification recall letter.



IMPORTANT REMINDER ON VEHICLES AFFECTED BY SAFETY & COMPLIANCE RECALLS

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a pre-owned motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.
