



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – 75B

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2019 and 2021 through 2024 Model Year (DT) Ram 1500 Pickup vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

Some of the above vehicles may experience an Antilock Braking System (ABS) control module software malfunction that can disable the Electronic Stability Control (ESC) system. Failure of the ESC system when intervention is expected and/or relied upon can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.

The condition described above does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 571.126 S5.1.2 ESC Functionality requires that the ESC system "Is operational during all phases of driving including acceleration, coasting, and deceleration (including braking) [...]." Suspect vehicles may experience the ESC system being disabled when certain conditions are met.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to update the ABS control module software. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 3rd Quarter of 2024.
