Dear Service Manager,

Service Bulletin SB-. CJ Broom Badger Models manufactured between May 5th, 2023, and May 30th, 2024 The fuel tank system originally used on the Broom Bader CJ may not meet the requirements of 49 CFR Part 393.67. The original fuel tank fill system may allow the tank to be filled to more than 95% of its volume. There is a possibility that a fuel leak could contribute to a fire. Elgin Broom Badger CJ street sweepers manufactured between May 5th, 2023, and May 30th, 2024, must be repaired per the repair instructions in Service Bulletin SB-0260. Your customers will be informed of this recall by certified mail Starting October 29, 2024.

Elgin Sweeper has developed a solution for this for this problem with FSO Kit #1144147. These parts will be available to order when the customer receives the notification. Please only order enough FSO Kits for the customers and units you are responsible for in the attached list, Appendix A, Customer List and Recalled Units. Any units that may be affected will be repaired at no charge to the customer. Customers will be asked to contact you to schedule the repair. We anticipate this repair to take approximately 1/2 hour. Please use the attached Recall Service Bulletin that will provide instructions for making the necessary repairs.
