Issue		Mercedes-Benz AG, the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain S-Class (223 platform) vehicles with an M176 8-cylinder gasoline engine with the cylinder deactivation feature, the lambda control in the Engine Control Unit software might not meet current production specifications. In the event of an independent hardware failure in the CAMTRONIC system, the amount of injected fuel might be erroneously increased by the lambda control system during cylinder deactivation. As a result, exhaust temperatures may increase and might damage surrounding components (e.g. engine wiring harness, catalytic converter). A loss of propulsion without warning and an increased risk of fire cannot be ruled out.
