Issue Description	<p>Porsche identified a potential issue in the battery cell modules installed in the high-voltage batteries in the affected vehicles. To address this issue, vehicles will be inspected and if determined necessary, specific modules within the battery will be replaced. Newly developed battery monitoring software will also be installed when available.</p>
What should Porsche Centers do?	<p>Please arrange to have the remedy performed on affected vehicles as soon as it is available.</p> <p>The remedy is not yet available at this time.</p>
What will Porsche do?	<p>Vehicles will have the remedy performed once it is available.</p> <p>Phase 1: The subject vehicles will be inspected at workshop to pull the VAL so that Porsche can check the HV battery state of health in order to determine if any cell modules need to be replaced. If any cell modules are found to be affected, the subject vehicles will be added to ARB5 Recall for the module replacement via EVBS. This is expected to begin in December 2024.</p> <p>Phase 2: The subject vehicles will receive a BMCe software update to be performed at the Porsche Center, which is expected in Q1 2025.</p>

Customer Reactive Statement	Our first priority is the safety and quality of our cars. We recently determined that there is a potential battery issue impacting 2020-2024 Taycan vehicles. If a customer's vehicle is affected, they will be notified via an email and a letter. If necessary, out-of-specification battery modules will be replaced and customers will be provided with alternative transportation while their vehicles are being remedied free of charge.
